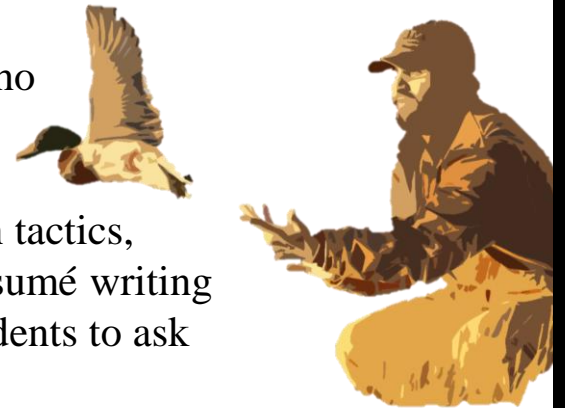


NADS7 Student/ Professional Mixer & Panel Discussion

Panel Discussion – A panel of young professionals who are employed in a waterfowl or wetland conservation related position will offer details about their path to employment. Topics will include: effective job search tactics, networking methods, job interview do's and don'ts, résumé writing tips, and more.
